Planning & Construction Process 2008 to 2012

2008 – November	Park Bonds Approved
2010 - Summer	HOK Landscape Architects selected to design park
2010 – Fall	Public Meetings Held
2010 – December	Liberty Ridge Concept Plan Approved
2011 – April	City Council set a \$750,000 construction budget
2011 - July	Revised Park Plan presented to meet budget
2011 - September	Revised Pavilion Design Approved
2011 - October	Authorized to Bid Project
2011 – December 6	Bid Awarded
2012 – January 17	Construction Begins
2012 – January 31	Ground Breaking Ceremony
2012 - October 6	Grand Opening Dedication Ceremony



LIBERTY RIDGE NEIGHBORHOOD PARK

FINAL DESIGN – October 2011

INCLUDES:

- Dredging pond and reusing the silt on site to enrich topsoil
- Grading a gentle slope down to the pond only on the east and west sides of pond to waters edge (north and south grades /elevations remain unchanged)
- Removing 18 trees due to new grades, transplanting on-site 12 of those trees, and planting 13 new trees
- Raising the ponds overflow outlet 9 inches for a 9 foot water depth water level standard that will increase the health of the pond and water quality
- Adding 2 needed aerators to increase aeration of pond for water quality
- Adding a fishing platform on east side
- Adding a group Pavilion with electric, group BBQ grill, and 4 picnic tables on the west side of pond
- Replacing the existing playground with a new toddler playground unit and adding 5-12 year age group playground units with shade umbrellas, & swings
- Adding 8 benches, 2 trash cans, and a drinking water fountain
- Installing all new irrigation
