


FAQ'S

Why was my class cancelled?

All instructors set a minimum number of participants they require for the class to be held. To ensure your class is held, please sign up in advance so our instructors have an accurate count of the participants.

Why do you not accept cash?

In order to avoid liability and safety concerns for front desk recreation staff members, it is city policy to not accept cash payments for recreation services.

Can you keep track of my daily passes, so I don't have to complete another form?

Daily passes are recorded as just that, a daily pass, and not linked to a household account. We require a signed form with your information for each daily pass you are issued so we are able to link your payment with your information.

I have the same zip code as Murphy but I live in Wylie, why can't I be a member for free?

Residency is determined by what city your home is located in, what city you pay your property taxes to and/or what city your water bill is paid to as opposed to the zip code in which you live.



Refunds:

Refunds may be applied to your household account with us for future use. A refund back to you will be made in the same form payment was received.

Activity Refunds: All refunds will be made to the original payer only. If you are receiving a refund to a credit card, please allow 5-10 days for processing. For check refunds please allow three weeks for processing. For a full refund, please make your request prior to the scheduled start time of the 2nd class meeting.

Rental Refunds: Refunds will be issued if rental is cancelled within five (5) working days before the date stated on the Rental Agreement. All reservation changes must be made five (5) working days in advance. Room rental deposits are refundable. Full refunds will be given if all room rental policies have been followed.

Pavilions: Pavilion reservations must be cancelled 24 hours in advance for full refund. You may reschedule your pavilion reservation on the day of your reservation prior to the reservation start time. 

Murphy Facility Rentals

- The Murphy Community Center and Murphy Activity Center accepts reservations in-person on a first come, first serve basis at the Community Center.
- Each applicant must provide payment in full by check or valid credit card with a signed contract.
- Reservations must be made up to 90 days in advance; and at least two (2) weeks prior to the requested date.
- Reservation start and end times must include set-up and clean-up.
- All reservations made require a \$100 refundable clean-up/damage deposit.
- All changes to a reservation must be made five (5) business days prior to the reserved date.
- For room rental pricing for Non-Profit groups, please contact our front desk at 972-4684-4444.



Athletic Field Reservation Policies & Procedures

Requests for field reservations must be submitted **via email** to recinfo@murphytx.org.

Reservations are first come, first served **based on email timestamp**.

Emails must contain the following:

- Team Name**
- Age/Gender of Team**
- Sport**
- Primary contact information**
- Coach information**

Reservations for Spring/Fall seasons run through:

Spring season (November - June):

Field request start November 1 at 12:01 a.m.

Fall season (June- November):

Field request start June 1 at 12:01 a.m.

- Reservations during peak times (Monday - Thursday) are limited to two (2) per week, one (1) hour maximum time limit per team/group.
- Soccer field reservations will be for ½ the field. Friday and Saturday reservations can be for the entire field.
- Sunday is OPEN play only. **NO** reservations permitted.
- Reservations are only available to citizens, business owners, and business workers within Murphy city limits.
- Reservation parties are responsible for disposing of litter in trash receptacles or taking it with them.
- Reserving parties must notify Recreation Staff when practices are cancelled so others may use the field.
- Field reservations may be made the same day, pending field availability.

Pavilion Reservations can be made:

Online at www.murphytx.org or **In person** at the Murphy Community Center at 205 N Murphy Road

Pavilion Fees

Residents: \$25 for 2 hour *minimum*, then \$10 per additional hour

Non-Residents: \$50 for 2 hour *minimum*, then \$10 per additional hour

- Reservations are first come first serve, with a paid reservation.
- Reservations may be made up to one (1) year in advance (limited to two consecutive years of reserving the same date).
- Time limit for reservation needs to include set-up and clean-up, so another group could be scheduled afterwards.
- Reservations are available to residents and non-residents.
- Reserve online (www.murphytx.org) or in person at the MCC.
- Pavilion reservations must be made the day before.

Pavilions Refunds:

Pavilion reservations must be cancelled 24 hours in advance for full refund. You may reschedule your pavilion reservation on the day of your reservation prior to the reservation start time. Please contact the Community Center for processing refunds or rescheduling.




