

The attached protest petition form must be used to submit zoning protests to the City of Murphy City Council. If signed by the owners of record of 1) twenty percent (20%) or more of any real property proposed to be rezoned, or 2) by the owners of record of twenty percent (20%) or more of the total real property within 200 feet of the proposed amendment, then such amendments shall only be approved by at least a supermajority vote of all members of the Murphy City Council.

A separate protest form must be submitted for each property whose owners are protesting the zoning case. In order to be considered, this form must be signed and filed with the City Secretary **by or before 5:00 pm** of the fifth business day immediately preceding the date noticed for the public hearing for the Murphy City Council (for example, if the council public hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, then the petition must be submitted by 5:00 pm on Tuesday of the prior week). If mailed, this protest form must be RECEIVED by the City Secretary before the 5:00 pm deadline. If ownership of the protester's property is different from that shown on the certified ownership list submitted by the applicant, it is the responsibility of the protestor to provide proof of ownership.

In completing this form, please:

- 1. Enter the information about the property against which the protest is made. This information can be found in the notice which you received on this case from the City of Murphy.**
- 2. Enter a complete address or a full legal description by lot, block, and addition (or by metes and bounds description) of your property.**
- 3. Enter your full name as owner of the property. If you are not the listed owner, but have legal authority to represent the owner or the property, please describe that authority. *Note: if the property is owned by a corporation, the protest must be signed by the president, a vice-president, or an attorney in fact authorized to sign on behalf of the corporation. If the property is owned by a general or limited partnership, the protest must be signed by a general partner or by an attorney in fact authorized to sign the protest on behalf of the partnership.***
