The Community Center Gym is open for Family Play only. Members of the same household or family group can practice basketball or volleyball skills together. All family members must have a membership and availability is first come, first served. Please call ahead to see if the gym is available.

- Membership cards are required for facility access.
- Memberships are free for Murphy residents who pay property taxes or receive a water bill from the City of Murphy.
- Children under 18 years of age must have a parent or legal guardian present to sign up for a membership.
- **Day Pass:** Any supervising adult (over 18) can sign for a youth or teen day pass.
- Lost or stolen cards will result in a \$3 replacement fee.
- Cards may not be damaged or altered.
- **All children ages 12 years and under must be accompanied by an adult member 18 years or older at all times to access and use the facility.**
- All game and athletic equipment is available for check out with a membership card or a valid ID for day pass users. Based on availability. Property of the City of Murphy.

MURPHY FACILITY RENTAL POLICIES

Reservations for the Murphy Community Center are made in-person at the Community Center on a first come, first serve basis.

- Reservations can be made up to 90 days in advance and must be made at least two (2) weeks prior to the requested date.
- Each applicant must provide payment in full by check or valid credit card at the time the reservation is made.
- Reservation start and end times must include set-up and clean-up.
- All reservations require a security deposit that may be refunded. See reservation policies for more details.
- All changes to a room reservation must be made five (5) business days prior to the reserved date.
- For room rental pricing for Non-Profit groups, please contact our front desk at 972-468-4444.
- No reservations on Fridays before 2pm.
- **No reservations on Sundays.**
- Gym can be reserved for banquets, meetings, etc. only on Saturdays between 5-10pm.
- Gym can be reserved for sports only on Saturdays.

Pavilion reservations can be made online at <https://reconline.murphytx.org> or in person at the Murphy Community Center at 205 N. Murphy Road up to the day of your reservation.

RESIDENT: \$25

for 2 hour minimum, then \$10 per additional hour

NON-RESIDENT: \$50

for 2 hour minimum, then \$10 per additional hour

- Reservations are first come first serve, with a paid reservation.
- Reservations may be made up to one year in advance (limited to two consecutive years of reserving the same date).
- Time limit for reservation needs to include set-up and clean-up, so another group could be scheduled right after.
- Reservations are available to Murphy residents and non-residents.
- The city reserves the right to modify these rules as necessary.
- Reservation parties are responsible for disposing of litter in trash receptacles or taking it off site.

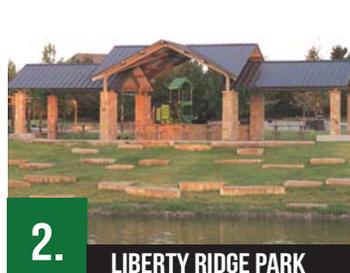

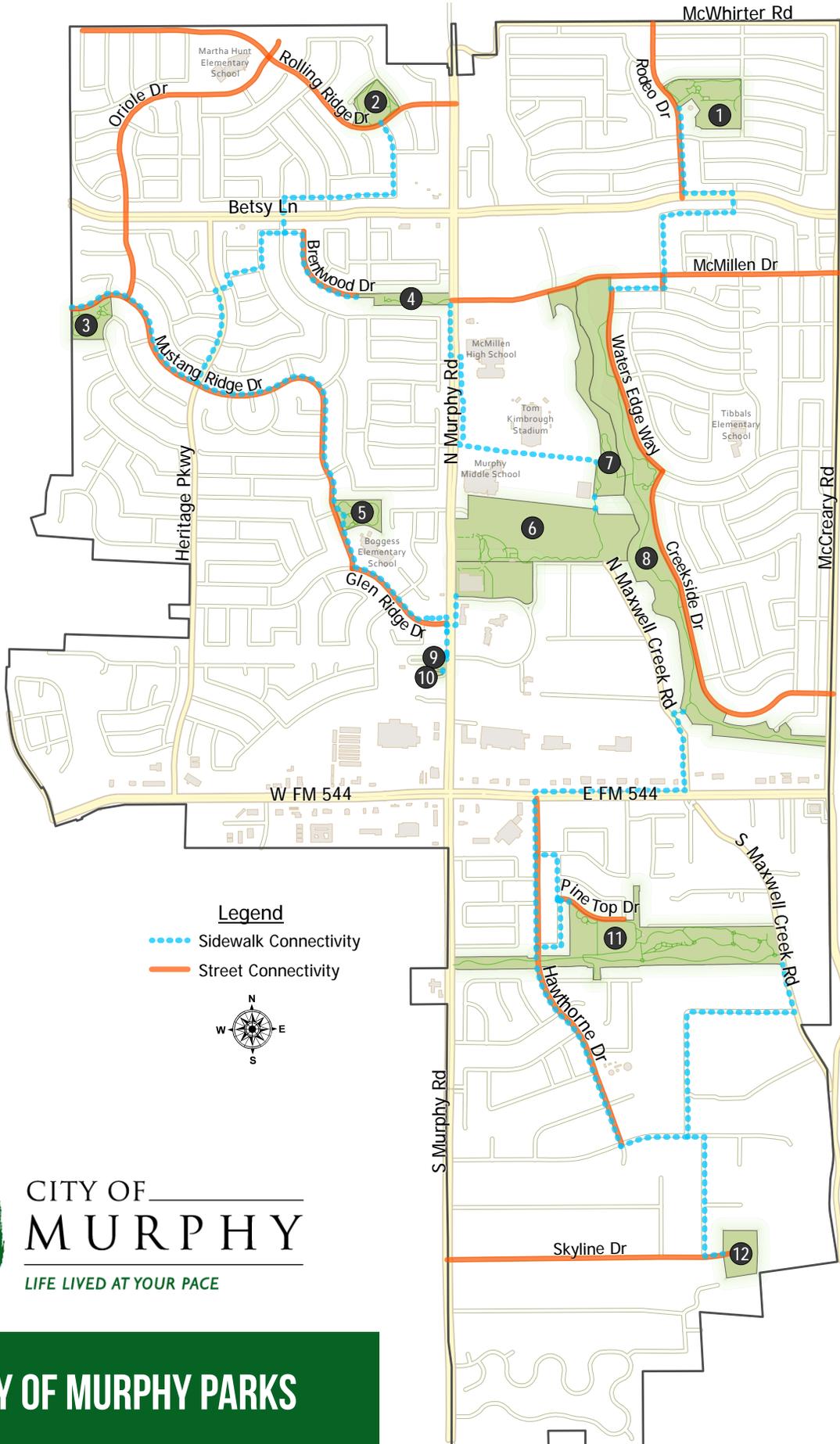

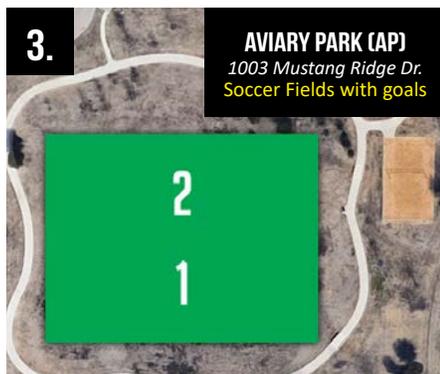

ATHLETIC FIELD POLICIES

- Reservations during peak times (**Monday - Thursday**) are limited to two (2) per week, one (1) hour maximum time limit **per person and/or team.**
- **Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, a reservation is required to hold organized practice.**
- Sunday is OPEN play only. NO reservations permitted.
- Reservations are only available to citizens, business owners, and business workers within Murphy city limits. **The individual who reserves the field must be onsite at the time of the field reservation.**
- Reservation parties are responsible for disposing of litter in trash receptacles or taking it off site.
- Reserving parties must notify Recreation Staff when practices are canceled so others may use the field. Field reservations may be made the same day, pending field availability.
- Fields are not lighted.
- Organized practice in open space around fields is prohibited.
- Fields may be closed due to weather or for maintenance at the discretion of the Parks Department.

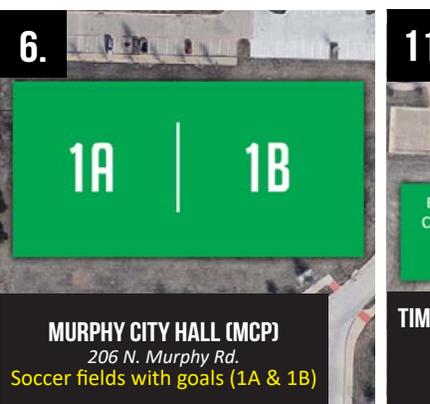
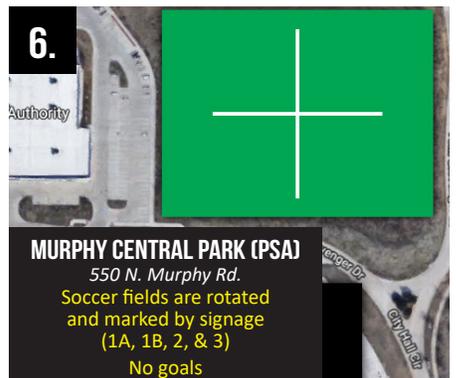

MCC FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why was my class canceled?

All instructors set a minimum number of participants required for the class to be held. To ensure your class is held, please sign up in advance so our instructors have an accurate count of the participants.

Why do you not accept cash?

In order to avoid liability and safety concerns for front desk recreation staff members, it is city policy to not accept cash payments for recreation services.

Can you keep track of my daily passes, so I don't have to complete another form?

Daily passes are recorded as just that, a daily pass, and not linked to a household account. We require a signed form with your information for each daily pass you are issued so we are able to link your payment with your information.

I have the same zip code as Murphy but I live in Richardson, why can't I be a member for free?

Residency is determined by what city your home is located in, what city you pay your property taxes to and/or what city your water bill is paid to as opposed the zip code in which you live.

PARKS & REC REFUNDS

Refunds may be applied to your user account for future use. A refund back to you will be made in the same form payment was received. All refunds will be made to the original payer only. For a credit card refund, please allow 10 days for processing (2% processing fee is non-refundable). For check refunds, please allow 30 days for processing.

Activity Refunds:

For a full refund, please make your request prior to the scheduled start time of the 2nd class meeting.

Rental Refunds:

Refunds will be issued if rental is canceled by five (5) working days before the date stated on the Rental Agreement. All reservation changes must be made five (5) working days in advance. Room rental deposits are refundable. A full deposit refund will be given if all room rental policies have been followed.

Pavilion Refunds:

Pavilion reservations must be canceled 24 hours in advance for full refund. You may reschedule your pavilion reservation on the day of your reservation prior to the reservation start time. Please contact the Community Center for processing refunds or rescheduling.
